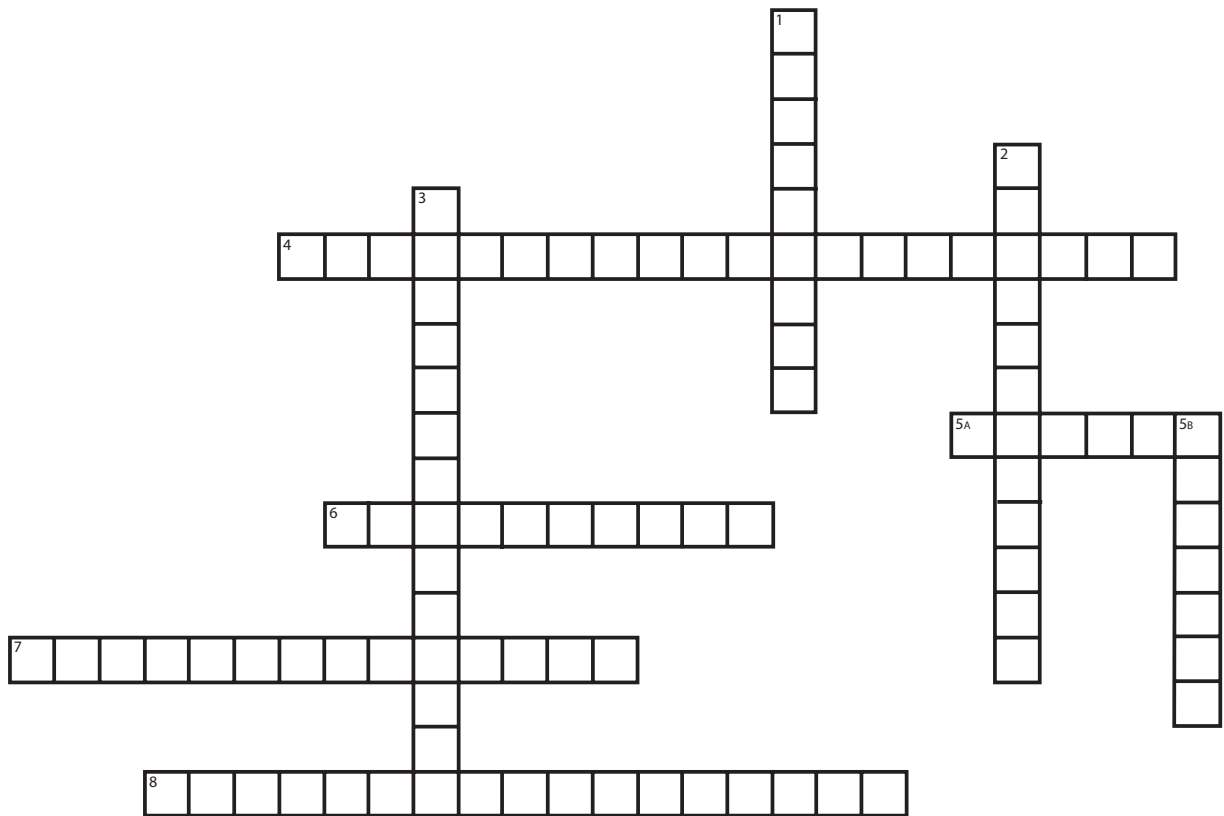


A Christmas CrossWord

This is not an ordinary crossword puzzle. It consists of phrases, with no spaces between the words (similar to puzzles such as the *New York Times* crossword). These are key phrases from Luke 2:4–14, words you have heard many times before. Use this to review the Bible narrative, but in a new way.



Another name for Bethlehem. (3 DOWN)

This means that Mary and Joseph were descendants/
relatives of King David. (4 ACROSS)

The message of the angel was good . . . (7 ACROSS).

The angel said this baby is . . . (5a ACROSS and 5b DOWN).

The sign of the Savior: a baby (8 ACROSS) and (1 DOWN).

The heavenly host sang (6 ACROSS) and (2 DOWN).
